1 Introduction

With effect from July 2013 all applicants for WDSF Adjudicator's License must pass this test as a prerequisite to obtaining a license.

Existing license holders will sit for the test at their convenience when they attend the Adjudicator's congress for license renewal or just to sit for a test at a congress of their choice. Adjudicators who have passed the test will have a special credit note on the WDSF website.

2 Objectives

2.1 English Comprehensive Test

Aims to ensure that the participants are able to understand spoken English and have a good sense of hearing.

2.2 General Knowledge Test

Provides guidelines to adjudicators to have a sound understanding of:

- a) the structure, operating policies and history of WDSF
- b) the new development within the WDSF
- c) the development of the judging system
- d) the Adjudicator's Code of Conduct
- e) the relevant chapters of the competition rules
- f) the Anti-doping rules and dress regulations
- g) the WDSF new techniques.

2.3 Academy

Assist the academy in formulating training content for adjudicators.



3 Test Content

3.1 Part 1 – Listening Comprehension

The examiner will act as chairman and read a passage to simulate a briefing for a competition. After which the candidates will have to answer 10 simple questions in written form.

This test will take no more than 15 minutes.

This test is for new applicants only.

3.2 Part 2

This will be a 100 questions test covering the topics below, all new applicants and existing license holders must take this test.
